When it's quite cold out, the "Check Engine" light comes on on my dash board. I phoned up a guy I take my car to for repairs, and he told me to bring the car to his place the following Monday. Over the weekend, the Check Engine light went off, but I figure that the fault code would still be stored in the computer's memory, so I brought ...

Your Nissan check engine light should come on under normal operation when you insert the key in the ignition. After 5 seconds or once you start the engine, the light should turn off as long as no fault codes are present. If the check engine light stays on, the problem can be something as simple as a loose gas cap or a faulty oxygen sensor.

The reason why the check engine light comes 'on' is because the car has failed some type of test. Whether that is a continuous monitor like misfires, or engine timing, or non continues monitor like the catalyst or the EVAP system, or air fuel ratio. That kind of stuff. So, it runs all these tests and when it sees a problem, it fails the test.

If the engine oil level is low, this is causing the oil warning light to flicker. This is most likely what is responsible for the occasional flickering of the oil warning light. More specifically, a low oil level will cause the oil pressure inside the engine to temporarily drop. When this happens, the warning light will flicker.

If your check engine light is on, you may have a defective O2 sensor that needs to be replaced. This engine component measures the amount of unburned oxygen in your exhaust system. If not replaced, this can lead to lower fuel-economy ratings, damaged spark plugs, a damaged catalytic converter and excess fuel burn.
