When you're in manual mode, you can shoot yourself in the foot all you want. This includes underexposing to the point of having a black frame. Check your meter. Unlike all the other automated modes, in M mode, the camera doesn't automatically adjust your settings to shove your meter's "needle" to 0. This is actually a feature, not a bug.

canon - How do I stop having a black screen in manual mode ...

Select the Custom shooting mode to register, then select [OK] on the [Register settings] screen. The current camera settings are registered to Custom shooting mode C*. Automatic Update of Registered Settings. If you change a setting while shooting in Custom shooting mode, the mode can be automatically updated with the new setting (Auto update).

Main Dial: Shutter speed setting in M mode - you can control the behavior of the vertical dial on the top of the camera in Manual mode to either change the Shutter speed (default) or Aperture. Quick Control Dial 2: Set ISO speed - this controls the top horizontal dial, which is by default used to adjust camera ISO.
